CARMEN Forum

The CARMEN Forum (previously 'Market Place') aims to facilitate outreach, connection and communication between individuals, organisations and projects. Each participant in the Forum is provided with a stall (free of charge), where they can display print materials or a digital presentation and discuss their project. Participants are also welcome to bring information about projects led by other colleagues. In a typical year, stalls represent a wide range of interests, including institutional research centres, publishers, and projects at various stages of development. CARMEN Workshops

The CARMEN Annual Meeting programme places an emphasis on interactive sessions which facilitate development of new projects and partnerships. Workshop sessions vary in length (usually between 45 and 75 minutes), and can present a project, or project idea, at any stage of development. Workshops are most successful when the convenor has a clear aim for the session and a plan for fostering discussion, and when the theme has cross-disciplinary reach. They are a valuable way to make links and find new collaborators.
